SEC. 51P-10.101. LEGISLATIVE HISTORY.

PD 10 no longer exists. PD 10 was established as a special permit by Ordinance No. 7906, passed by the Dallas City Council on January 12, 1959. Ordinance No. 7906 amended basic Zoning Ordinance No. 5238, passed by the Dallas City Council on August 28, 1951. Ordinance No. 7906 was amended by Resolution No. 61-5035, passed by the Dallas City Council on October 23, 1961. The special permit created by Ordinance No. 7906 was converted to PD 10 by Comprehensive General Zoning Ordinance No. 10962, passed by the Dallas City Council on March 29, 1965. Ordinance No. 7906 was further amended by Ordinance No. 14234, passed by the Dallas City Council on August 27, 1973, and Ordinance No. 16510, passed by the Dallas City Council on March 12, 1980. Subsequently, Ordinance No. 20062 was adopted by the Dallas City Council on September 14, 1988. Ordinance No. 20062 changed the zoning on the Property from PD 10 to PD 281. (Ord. PD 10 was established on property generally bounded by Richmond Avenue, Gaston Avenue, Prospect Avenue, and Abrams Road. (Ord. Nos. 7906; 14234; 24637)
