

- Note**
1. Irrigation contractor to verify location of existing service connections and solenoid valves to remain connected to the controllers.
  2. Electric service at the controller locations will be provided by the Owner. Co-ordinate with Mr. Baldwin at 458-2601.
  3. Time of operation of the turf areas and shrub areas will be separate schedules. Exact times will be set by the designer at final acceptance.
  4. Static water pressure of at least 60 psi should be measured at all points of connection prior to construction. If lower notify H.O.K.

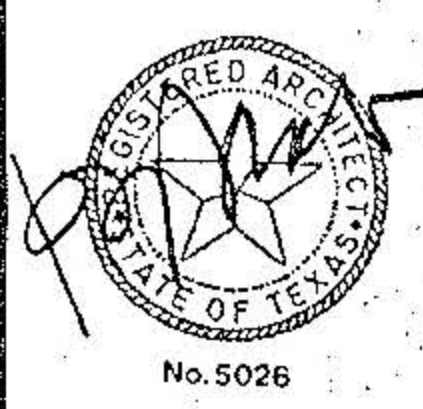
